MILESTONES IN SAN FELICE WINES



FIRST SUPER TUSCAN

- **1968** San Felice launches **Vigorello** (wine of vigour), thus becoming the first estate to produce a wine in the Chianti Classico area without the use of white grapes as was required by the appellation's regulatory code. This was the wine that spawned the Super Tuscan class.



IL GRIGIO

- **1969** first production of **Il Grigio da San Felice**, with a label depicting Gregorio Vecelio, father of the painter Titian and captain of the Centuria of Pieve di Cadore (Belluno), also known as *Il Grigio*.



IL CRÛ

- **1978** first year of production of **Poggio Rosso**, at the time a rare example of a Chianti Classico *crû*, testifying to San Felice's commitment to enhancing the image of the appellation. The name derives the vineyard of the same name from which the grapes are harvested.



UNIQUE BLEND IN THE CHIANTI CLASSICO AREA

- **2014** First production of **Il Grigio Gran Selezione**, the result of painstaking selection of our best Sangiovese cultivated in 5 zones of excellence in our production area, combined with a 20% complement made up of 5 exceptional native varieties brought back to prominence in the San Felice Vitiarium: Abrusco, Pugnitello, Malvasia Nera, Ciliegiolo and Mazzese.
